Re: APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A; Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A; Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A; and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A; JAMESTOWN FIELD, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.

Dear Sir:

EMPRESA ENERGY, LP ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A; Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A; Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A; and to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A; all in the Jamestown Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create one (1) drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, such unit being shown on an attached plat and being designated CV RA SUA.
2. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, such unit being shown on an attached plat and being designated HOSS A RA SUN.
3. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, such unit being shown on an attached plat and being designated HOSS B RA SUP.
4. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit being shown on an attached plat and being designated HA RA SUD.

5. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.

6. To propose that future wells drilled to the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Jamestown Field be located no closer than 1,000 feet to any unit boundary and no closer than 2,000 feet to any well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A.

7. To designate a unit well for, and a unit operator of, each of the proposed units as may be appropriate.

8. To provide that with respect to any horizontal well drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary or offset well will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus of the well in the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.

9. To permit the operator of the units proposed herein to combine downhole production from the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A; the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A; and the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A; or from any combination thereof, in the wellbore of any well on these units in which the ownership interests in the units from which production is to be combined downhole are identical.

10. To define the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, as the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 9,426 feet and 10,305 feet in the Questar Exploration & Production Co. (formerly Will-Drill Production Co., Inc.)--Sustainable Forest 28 No. 1 Well, located in Section 28, Township 15 North, Range 9 West, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.

11. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 999-B, effective November 27, 1990, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 999-B series of Orders, to the proposed additional unit for the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A.

12. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 999-C, effective November 27, 1990, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 999-C series of Orders, to the proposed additional unit for the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A.

13. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 999-D, effective October 6, 2009, to the proposed additional unit for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.

14. To discuss such other matters as may be pertinent to any of these proposals.

The Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, in the Jamestown Field is defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 999-B, effective November 27, 1990.

The Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, in the Jamestown Field is defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 999-C, effective November 27, 1990.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Jamestown Field is defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 999-D, effective October 6, 2009.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Boulevard, Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person desiring to inspect any such data should call Mr. Louis Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


By letter dated June 8, 2010, Applicant gave notice, in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure, of its intention to apply for a public hearing concerning these proposals and set June 30, 2010, as the tentative date for the pre-application conference. No timely conference request was received; accordingly, no pre-application conference will be held.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of each of the unit plats (which are identical to the unit plats attached to the pre-application notice) is enclosed herewith, and a copy of this letter and of the attached plats is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to each of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plats, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Jamestown Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.



 HOSS B ZONE, RESERVOIR A





 BIENVILLE PARISH, LOUISIANA


PROPOSED UNIT PLAT
