

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 10, 2010**, upon the application of **XTO ENERGY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Gray Sand, Reservoir E**, in the Cotton Valley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the Gray Sand, Reservoir E, insofar and only insofar as to the existing unit GRAY RE SUK, as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 11,090' and 12,145' (electrical log measurements) in the XTO Energy Inc.-VH Clement 15 No. 1 Well, located in Section 15, Township 21 North, Range 10 West.
2. To confirm the unit designated GRAY RE SUK as remaining in full force and effect as a drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Gray Sand, Reservoir E, as redefined in the manner set forth above.
3. To confirm Applicant as operator of and its VH Clement 15 No. 1 Well as the unit well for GRAY RE SUK.
4. To continue in full force and effect, except to the extent contrary herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 10-EE-10, effective September 10, 2002, as amended and supplemented by the 10-EE Series of Orders and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the unit GRAY RE SUK.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Gray Sand, Reservoir E was defined in Order No. 10-EE-18, effective November 27, 2007.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
