LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2010**, upon the application of **EXPERT OIL & GAS, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry Zone, Reservoir D and Nonion Struma Sand, Reservoir D**, in the Gillis-English Bayou Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir D and Nonion Struma Sand, Reservoir D.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir D and Nonion Struma Sand, Reservoir D and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created in accordance with Section 10, Title 30 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each separate tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator for the unit so created.
4. To provide that future wells drilled to the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir D and Nonion Struma Sand, Reservoir D, within or outside of the proposed unit shall be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir so created, by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackberry Zone was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 252-FF, effective February 1, 2000, as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,528' and 10,988' (electrical log measurements) (9,362' tvd and 9,762' tvd) in the Samson Resources Company-SL 15774 No. 1 Well, located in Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 8 West and is further defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of the zone encountered between the depths of 9,950' and 10,625' (electrical log measurements) in the Wainoco Oil & Gas-William A. Powers No. 1 Well, located in Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 8 West.

The Nonion Struma Sand was previously defined in Order No. 252-GG, effective February 1, 2000 as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 11,132' and 11,182' (electrical log measurements) (9,889' tvd and 9,930' tvd) in the Samson Resources Company-SL 15774 No. 1 Well, located in Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 8 West.
