Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **HOUSTON ENERGY, L.P.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the following: Alliance Sand, Reservoir G, and 12,500 Sand, Reservoir B, all in the Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, said units to be designated ALL RG SUA and 12500 RB SUA, respectively, as shown on the plats attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to each of the reservoirs, within or outside the units created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify each of the reservoirs by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of each reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The 12,500 Sand, in Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 557-L, effective May 3, 1983.








**ALL RG SUA


