LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 31, 2010**, upon the application of **DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION COMPANY, L.P.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A, and the Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as HOSS 7,850 RA SUG is concerned, by removing from the definition of that gas and condensate bearing zone the oil sand which will be herein defined as the Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A, being that oil bearing sand encountered between depths of 7,910' and 7,922' (electrical log measurements) in the Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. – Colvin-Kilgore No. 2 Well located in Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 2 West.
2. To otherwise confirm that the unit for the Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A Zone, designated HOSS 7,850 RA SUG, is in full force and effect, as amended hereby.
3. To establish rules and regulations and create one drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil from the Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A, to be designated HOSS 7,850 OIL RA SUA, as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within the proposed unit in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To designate Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. as the unit operator and the Colvin-Kilgore No. 2 Well as the unit well for HOSS 7,850 OIL RA SUA, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
6. To provide that future wells drilled to the Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A, within or outside the proposed unit, be located no closer than 330' to any unit boundary and no closer than 660' to any well drilling to, completed in, or for which a permit shall have been granted to the Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 164-O-29, effective January 10, 1995.

The Hosston 7,850' Oil Sand, Reservoir A Zone, Reservoir A, is defined as that oil bearing sand encountered between the depths of 7,910' and 7,922' (electrical log measurements) in the Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. – Colvin-Kilgore No. 2 Well located in Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 2 West.
