APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Petrohawk Operating Company hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Chemard Lake Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Chemard Lake Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, to be designated HA RA SUQ, as shown outlined on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within the proposed unit in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate a unit well and unit operator, as appropriate;
4. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in or to serve the proposed unit, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
5. To extend the pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 700-G, effective April 28, 2009, as amended and supplemented by the 700-G Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed unit, except to the extent inconsistent herewith; and

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6. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Chemard Lake Field, DeSoto and Natchitoches Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 700-G, effective April 28, 2009.



A pre-application conference with respect to this matter was held on July 14, 2010. The attendees of the conference are identified on the list attached hereto. Bill Fleming and Craig Barclay on behalf of Petrohawk Operating Company explained the Applicant's proposal. Questions were asked and answered. There was no opposition expressed to the proposed unitization, although questions were raised by the representatives of AEP/Swepeco, et al, who were present. It appears they will participate in the hearing.

A copy of this notice, with plat attached, is being sent to each such party. Pursuant to Office of Conservation regulations, the list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be provided to any person requesting a copy of it.



