LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2010**, upon the application of **BOPCO, LP**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **UL-5 Sand, Reservoir K** and **UL-5 Sand, Reservoir L**, in the Pointe-a-la-Hache Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the single drilling and production unit created for the UL-5 Sand, Reservoir K by Office of Conservation Order No. 462-G-12, effective February 26, 2008.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the UL-5 Sand, Reservoir L.
3. To create a single drilling and production unit for the UL-5 Sand, Reservoir L, such unit being designated UL-5 RL SUA.
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To designate Applicant as operator of, and its State Lease 1212 No. 1 Well, located as shown on the plat submitted with the application, as the unit well for, the proposed unit UL-5 RL SUA, in exception to the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To provide that any future substitute or alternate unit well for the proposed unit UL-5 RL SUA be exempt from the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the UL-5 Sand, Reservoir L, by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification of the reservoir be warranted, based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
8. To define the UL-5 Sand, Reservoir L as that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 10,810' and 10,929' in the BOPCO, LP-SL 1212 No. 1 Well (SN 240381), located in Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 14 East.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The UL-5 Sand, Reservoir K was redefined in Order No. 462-G-12, effective February 26, 2008.
