LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2010**, upon the application of **HELIS OIL & GAS COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **N-1 Sand, Reservoir A, N-2 Sand, Reservoir B, O Sand, Reservoir B, Q-1 Sand, Reservoir A, Q-2 Sand, Reservoir A, and R Sand, Reservoir B**, in the West Black Bay Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the N-1 Sand, Reservoir A, N-2 Sand, Reservoir B, O Sand, Reservoir B and Q-2 Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Q-1 Sand, Reservoir A.
3. To dissolve the existing R RB SUA and R RB SUB established by Office of Conservation Order No. 437-G-1, effective November 3, 1976, and simultaneously therewith, create revised units for the R Sand, Reservoir B, designated R RB SUA and R RB SUB.
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To designate Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC as unit operator and its Cutrer No. 6 Well as unit well for the proposed R RB SUA at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application in exception to the spacing provisions of Order No. 437-G-1, effective November 13, 1976.
6. To designate Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC as operator and its SL 195 QQ No. 30ST Well as unit well for the proposed Q-1 RA SUR at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application in exception to the spacing provisions of Order No. 437-D-5, effective January 13, 2009.
7. To provide that any future wells drilled to the N-1 Sand, Reservoir A, N-2 Sand, Reservoir B, O Sand, Reservoir B and Q-2 Sand, Reservoir A within or outside of the units created herein, should be located no closer than fifty feet from the nearest unit line with no minimum spacing between offset wells completed in the same intervals.
8. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoirs by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
9. To extend to the proposed additional unit for the Q-1 Sand, Reservoir A, all pertinent provisions of Order No. 437-D, effective August 16, 1964, as amended and supplemented by the 437-D Series of Orders, and applicable Statewide Orders.
10. To extend to the proposed revised R Sand, Reservoir B, all pertinent provisions of Order No. 437-G-1, effective November 3, 1976, and applicable Statewide Orders.
11. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The N-1 Sand, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 7,252' and 7,282' (electrical log measurements) (7,146' and 7,176' tvd) in Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC-N. Cutrer No. 6 Well, located in Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 17 East.

The N-2 Sand, Reservoir B is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 7,312' and 7,358' (electrical log measurements) (7,206' and 7,252' tvd) in Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC-N. Cutrer No. 6 well, located in Section 18, Townshp 17 South, Range 17 East.

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The O Sand, Reservoir B is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 7,404' and 7,424' (electrical log measurements) (7,298' and 7,318' tvd) in Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC-N. Cutrer No. 6 Well, located in Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 17 East.

The Q-1 Sand was previously defined in Order No. 437-D, effective August 16, 1964.

The Q-2 Sand, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 8,233' and 8,310' (electrical log measurements) (8,127' and 8,204' tvd) in Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC-N. Cutrer No. 6 Well, located in Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 17 East.

The R Sand, Reservoir B was previously defined in Order No. 437-G-1, effective November 3, 1976.
