Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **Forest Oil Corporation**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create two (2) single drilling and production units of approximately 640 acres each for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SUR and SUT, designated as the HA RA SUR and HA RA SUT, Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plats;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To provide that, with respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within the proposed units where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
5. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A in the Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 628-B, effective November 3, 2009, as amended and supplemented by the 628-B Series of Orders.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Natchitoches, Louisiana on August 16, 2010. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of the names and addresses of the parties who were in attendance at that conference.

The conference was opened by Mr. William F. Bailey. Mr. David Comeaux of Leon Comeaux & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. It is not anticipated that there will be opposition at the public hearing on this matter.


