

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2010**, upon the application of **SAMUEL GARY, JR. & ASSOCIATES, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry Zone, Reservoir A, and Nodosaria blanpiedi Sand, Reservoir A**, in the South Black Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create one (1) drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Nodosaria blanpiedi Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir A.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To provide that future wells drilled to the Nodosaria blanpiedi Sand, Reservoir A on or outside of the proposed unit, be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
5. To permit the unit well for HBY RA SUE to be drilled to the bottom hole location shown on the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir A, unit plat, to any bottom hole location within fifty (50) feet thereof, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 838-F, effective December 17, 2002.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the Nodosaria blanpiedi Sand, Reservoir A, by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To define the Nodosaria blanpiedi Sand, Reservoir A, as the interval encountered between the measured depths of 13,058' and 13,118' (12,918' to 12,978' tvd) in the Samuel Gary, Jr. & Associates, Inc.-RE Odom 21 No. 1 Well, located in Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 12 West.
8. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Order No. 838-F, effective December 17, 2002, as amended and supplemented by the 838-F Series of Orders and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional unit for the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir A.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackberry Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 838-F, effective December 17, 2002.
