Nomination and Tract Committee Agenda

A meeting of the Nomination and Tract Committee of the State Mineral and Energy Board will be held on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, immediately following the Lease Review Committee Meeting, in the LaBelle Room, First Floor, of the LaSalle Building, located at 617 North Third Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

I. PRESENT LEASE SALE

- A. Previous approval by the Board was granted to the staff to process and advertise 116 tracts in the official journal of the state and in the official journal of the parish where the lands are located for the May 9, 2012 mineral lease sale.
- B. Request by applicant to pull Tracts 42603, 42604 and 42605 (all located in Avoyelles Parish, Louisiana) from the May 9, 2012 lease sale and place in the June 13, 2012 lease sale.
- C. Letter of Protest from Jeanerette Lumber & Shingle Co., L.L.C. regarding Tracts 42618, 42620, 42621, 42627, 42628, 42629, 42630, 42631, 42632, 42634, 42635, 42640, 42641, 42642 and 42643, situated in Assumption, Iberia and St. Martin Parishes, LA.
- D. Letters of Protest from Williams Land Company, L.L.C. and Williams, Inc., all dated May 3, 2012, regarding Tracts 42611, 42614, 42615, 42618, 42620, 42623, 42626, 42627, 42628, 42630, 42631, 42634, 42635, 42641 and 42642, being situated in and/or Iberia, St. Martin and Assumption parishes, Louisiana.
- E. Letters of Protest from Salt Domes, Partnership, all dated May 3, 2012, regarding Tracts 42618, 42627, 42628, 42635, 42642 and 42643, situated in St. Martin parish, Louisiana.
- F. Letters of Protest from Weeks Family, LLC, all dated May 3, 2012, regarding Tract 42622, Assumption parish, Louisiana and Tract 42628, St Martin parish, Louisiana.

II. FUTURE LEASE SALE

- A. 29 nominations received at the Office of Mineral Resources for the July 11, 2012 lease sale are pending approval by the Board for advertising.

The Committee may discuss other matters as it desires pursuant to R.S. 42.7(A)(1)(b)(ii) as well as Executive Session matters pursuant to R.S. 42.6.1(A)(2) and R.S. 42.6.1(A)(6).

The agenda shall include consideration of letters of protest which were submitted after the agenda proper was finalized but prior to the Mineral and Energy Board meeting at which the tracts which were the subject of those protest letters will be offered for bid.
