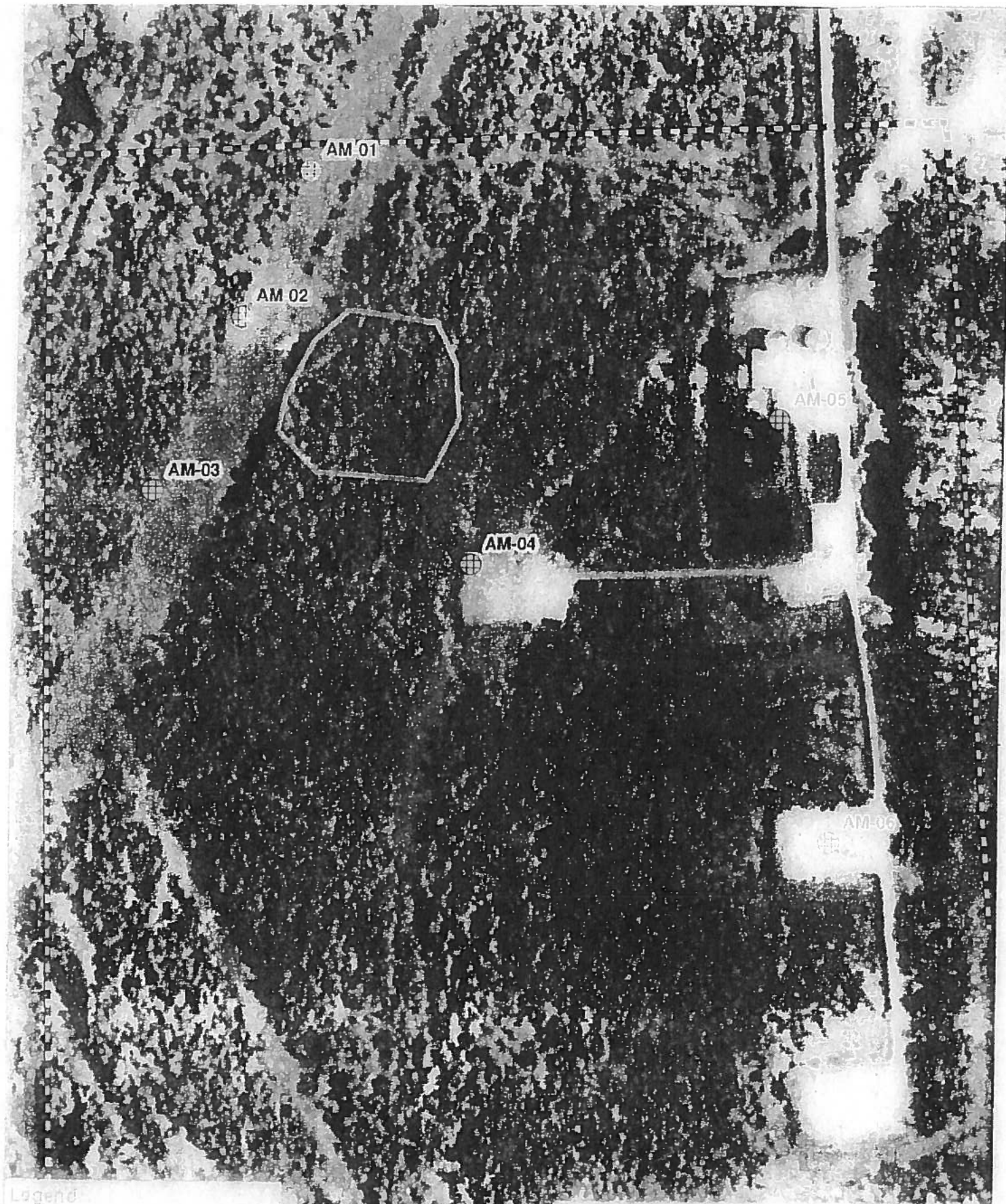

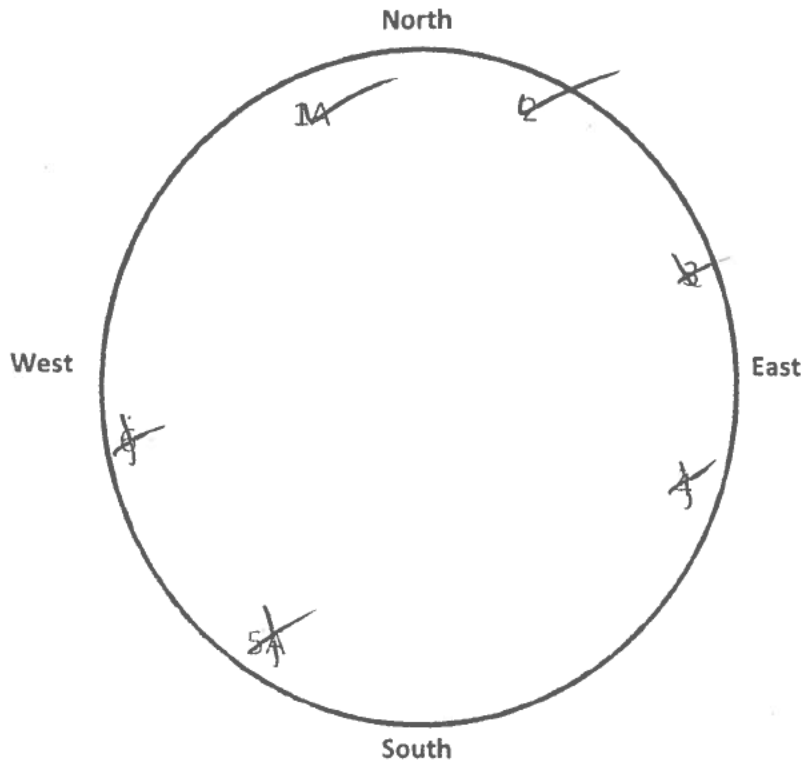
Map Title: Tex 13 Bine Air Monitoring Locations
