

Form Comp - Overview

1. Review Form Comp for accuracy prior to data entry – District stamp; operator, field, well name associated with serial number; completion/recompletion date within 1-year; product matches LUW; valid status change
 1. See following slides for data review for each type
 2. If anything questionable, forward to Permits engineer for review
2. Completion types of Form Comps:
 - a) LUW Assignment
 - b) No LUW Assignment
 - i. Amendment required
 - ii. Cross unit well
 - iii. Water
3. Recompletion types will either:
 - a) Have a LUW already and do not require LUW update;
 - b) Have a LUW already and require LUW update via Form Comp;
 - c) Have a LUW already and require update via Amendment;
 - d) Does not have a LUW and requires assignment via Form Comp; or
 - e) Does not have a LUW and requires assignment via Amendment
 - f) Does not have a LUW and does not require LUW
4. Key in data
 1. See slides for data entry – Form Comp and optional LUW Assignment
5. Forward to Well Files for imaging

Note – see Wildcat guide for completions in Wildcat Field. If successful, well MUST be placed in Field. Cannot remain Wildcat.

SECTION X, PARAGRAPH B OF ORDER NO. 29-B

Allowables given to wells for oil produced on drill stem tests, production test and miscellaneous production of oil shall be in accordance with the following rule:

All operators are required within five days, to file three signed copies of the record of the daily production from the well, showing the number of hours the well produced and the interval of production – as "form 8.00 A.M., August 5 to 3:00 P.M., August 8, 1952."
