API Updates

API Updates are triggered by changes in a well's surface location (ie, location amendment to different Parish/State prior to drilling); to correct an erroneous API; or to assign an API to a well that has never had an API in the SONRIS database.


Per API Bulletin D12A, P2 Energy Solutions assigns historic APIs for wells permitted before 7/1/1966. Irma Barrera is the primary contact. She will reach out from time-to-time for API corrections. Submit requests to EnR.WSupport2@ifs.com.

Verify the corrected API isn't being utilized by another well serial number before making the correction. If there is a conflict, consult with Irma.


Duals, triples, repermits, and redrills will share the same API.

A future enhancement to SONRIS will be to include API in the well history table (or perhaps its own set of tables since a lateral could have multiple APIs if we utilized the last 4 digits of the API- up until now, the last 4 digits in SONRIS are 0000).



- 1. Query Serial number (date doesn't really matter) leave as correction.
- 2. Change API number
- 3. Verify *Delete everything in the comment box* Enter Comment to "TO UPDATE API NUMBER TO 17-017-16542" or something similar.



- 4. Single Green Card
- 5. Update Well
- 6. Print only first page on white paper, cut in half, give the well file copy to well files to be imaged.
