Lonquist comment:

Regarding the SNT dataset, an image was scheduled to be acquired on June 24, but was unsuccessful. The communication from TREA is below:

I would like to provide you an update on the missing Sentinel-1 image (2024-06-24) over Sulphur Mine. Although, according to the European Space Agency (ESA) plan, the image was scheduled to be acquired, the acquisition has failed.

Our contact at ESA explained that Sentinel-1 is currently in an eclipse period, which runs from the beginning of May until early August, which may lead to a marginally higher likelihood of image acquisition rejections worldwide.

We'll continue to closely monitor the upcoming Sentinel-1 acquisition plans over Sulphur Mine and will be sure to let you know immediately if there are any changes or updates.
