Office of Conservation Rules and Regulations

Use of Reclaimed Oilfield Waste (ROW) for Downhole Well Operations

LAC 43:XIX.301, 303, 311, 313, 501, 519 & 565

## Dear Oversight Authorities:

The Commissioner of Conservation proposes to amend LAC 43:XIX.301, 303, 311, 313, 501, 519 & 565 in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act R.S. 49:950 et seq., and pursuant to the power delegated under the laws of the state of Louisiana. The proposed rule changes expand the use of produced water for all downhole well operations and allow operator-to-operator transfers. Benefits of these amendments include conservation of fresh water resources; reduced costs associated with disposal, transportation and water sourcing; reduced truck traffic and strain on disposal infrastructure..

In accordance with La R.S. 49:968.B and C. the Commissioner forwarded a Notice of Intent on January 19, 2023 for the proposed amendments to the appropriate legislative committees, presiding officers of the House and Senate, and other state offices.

A public comment period held open until March 10, 2023, which afforded interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed rule amendments. Pursuant to La R.S. 49:968.D(1)(b), the Commissioner of Conservation submits the following summary report.

I. La R.S. 49:968.D(1)(b)(i) – A summary of public hearing testimony:

No hearing was requested so no hearing was held.
