The proposed action is a rule amendment for the rule which sets application filing fees for Class VI wells for carbon sequestration. Minor clarifying amendments are proposed based on comment feedback from the regulated community.

La R.S. 30:1110.

IV. Statement of the circumstances requiring adoption of the rule per La R.S. 49:968.C(4):

During the public comment for the Notice of Intent to promulgate Statewide Order No. 29-N-7, the Office of Conservation received comments from stakeholders requesting additional clarification and transparency on a number of processes referenced in the draft rule at that time. Due to the sensitive timing with the promulgation of the original rule, the Office on Conservation committed to addressing the relevant concerns during future rulemaking.

V. Statement of the fiscal and economic impact of the proposed rule per La R.S. 49:968.C(5):

The fiscal and economic impact statement is attached to this report.

A notice of intent to initiate rule-making will be published in the Louisiana Register on December 20, 2024, with a public comment period on the proposed rule scheduled to remain open until January 24, at 5:00 PM. A public hearing is not currently scheduled, but if requested will be held on the evening of Thursday, January 23, 2025.
