The Commissioner of Conservation proposes to amend LAC 43:XIII:Chapters 3-35 and LAC 33:Part V. Chapter 301 in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act R.S. 49:950 et seq., and pursuant to the power delegated under the laws of the state of Louisiana.

The Louisiana Office of Conservation proposes to amend LAC 43:XIII:Chapters 3-35 and LAC 33:Part V. The proposed rule changes are required as a part of the Department of Natural Resources certification agreement with the US Department of Transportation and are intended to adopt existing federal regulations as state regulations.
