After-the-Fact Permit Definition

LAC 43:I §7.00

A coastal use permit which is issued after the commencement of a use. Such a permit may only be issued after all legal issues resulting from the commencement of a use without a coastal use permit have been resolved.



Use Definition

LAC 43:I §7.00

Any use or activity within the coastal zone which has a direct and significant impact on coastal waters.



Statutory Authority LRS 49:214.36

- The secretary (LDENR) and each local government with an approved program shall initiate a field surveillance program to ensure the proper enforcement of the management program.
- §214.26 Program Administration
- §214.28 Local Coastal Mgmt Programs
- §214.30 Coastal Use Permits



Statutory Authority LRS 49:214.36

- Cease & Desist
- Suspend, Revoke or otherwise Modify CUPs
- Civil liabilities, assess for damages, restoration
- Establishes the administrative penalty system



Administrative Penalty System

- B(V+P+C+I) = Penalty
- \$B is the base assessment
 - Permit app fee + processing fee, (or \$50 where no fee would have been charged)
- Processing Fee LAC 43:I §723
 - Residential = \$20 + \$0.04(#cy dredge/fill vol
 between 125 50,000)
 - <125 = \$0 additional
 - >50K = \$2,000 maximum



Administrative Penalty System (cont'd)

- Processing Fee LAC 43:I §723
 - Non-Residential = \$100 + \$0.05(#cy dredge/fill
 vol between 500 100,000)
 - <500 = \$25 additional
 - >100K = \$5,000 maximum



Administrative Penalty System (cont'd)

- B(V+P+C+I) = Penalty
- V is the habitat value
- P is the prior knowledge value
- C is the cooperation value
- I is the impact damage value
 - Values are variable from 0.5 to 1.5
- Minimum APS = \$50
- Maximum APS = \$12,000



Louisiana Office of Coastal Management

- Possible Violation Referral
 - Citizen Complaint
 - Field Biologist (Possible Violation Investigation)
 - Permits (App indicates UA work)
 - Referral from outside agencies, other sources



- OCM opens and tracks all referrals.
 - SONRIS Enforcement
 - Preliminary Determination (pre-review)
 - Exempt, Local determinations
 - Document Access (post-review)
 - Letters, APS, Mitigation, Final Authorizations



- If no app and determination can't be made,
 - Contact Responsible Party
 - Request Application Submittal
 - Request Field Investigation



State/Local Determination

State Concerns

- Dredge/Fill intersecting >1 water body
- Uses on State owned lands/waters
- State publically funded projects
- Projects of National Interest
- Projects occurring in Multiple parishes
- All mineral activities/pipelines involving minerals
- Energy facilities
- Any use significantly affecting state interests



State/Local Determination

Local Concerns

- Private funded, not state concern
- Public funded (local), not state concern
- Maintenance, not a state concern
- Jetties/Breakwaters
- Dredge/Fill not intersecting >1 water body
- Bulkheads/Piers/Camps/Cattlewalks
- Maintenance Dredging
- Private WCS (under \$15,000 cost)
- Uses of Cheniers, saltdomes, similar, etc.



- Sources of Information for Enforcement
 - Citizen/Complainant Info
 - Application Info
 - Field Investigation Info
 - Parish Tax Assessor's DB
 - Secretary of State Corporate/Business DB
 - Google
 - Facebook/LinkedIn/Social Media



- Communication Correspondence
 - Enforcement letters
 - Application or Info Request
 - Warning Letters
 - Incomplete Application Letters
 - APS/Processing Fee Letters
 - Cease & Desist
 - Compliance Order
 - Mitigation/Restoration
 - ATF Permitting



- Lack of Communication
 - Email Read-Receipt
 - Certified/Registered Mail Receipts
 - Increased penalties / civil liabilities
 - Increased mitigation temporal loss
 - Compliance Orders
 - DOJ AG Office
 - Time




OCM Enforcement Coordination
