Austin Chalk Activity in La.

The Austin Chalk play in Louisiana is experiencing a resurgence in activity. New horizontal drilling and completion techniques have resulted in substantial production rates. The majority of the production has Historicaly occurred in the western half of the state but new permitting and leasing activity is

concentrated in the central and eastern portions of the play in Rapides, Avoyelles, Pointe Coupee, East Feliciana and West Feliciana parishes.

The EOG – Eagle Ranch 14-1H, drilled in Avoyelles parish and completed 9-11-2017, tested at a rate of 1120 BOPD + 1157 MCFD. There are several recently permitted wells targeting the Austin Chalk in central and eastern Louisiana with two wells currently being drilled by ConocoPhillips in the Feliciana parishes.
