

The March 2014 average gas spot price was \$4.76 per MMBTU. However, it was 17.0% lower than the February 2014 price and 30.8% more than last year's corresponding average. Working gas in storage was 896 BCF as of Friday, March 21, 2014, according to EIA estimates. This represents a net decline of 57 BCF from the previous week. Stocks were 50.1% less than last year at this time, 50.8% below the 5-year average of 1,822 BCF, and for the first time since 2003, the stocks are below 900 BCF. Natural Gas Week reported that Mr. Michael Lynch, President of Strategic Energy & Economic Research, predicted gas prices will be in the range of \$3.50 to \$4.50 per MMBTU (adjusted for inflation) for the foreseeable future.


