

LNG terminals in the U.S. are changing their plans to accommodate the export of LNG. The United States has thirteen existing LNG terminals designed to import LNG, three of them are in Louisiana: Trunkline LNG, Lake Charles; Sabine Pass LNG, Sabine; and Cameron LNG, Hackberry. Louisiana has the highest liquefied natural gas (LNG) import/export capacity in the U.S., with a combined capacity of 7.9 Billion cubic feet per day (Bcfd). Louisiana's facilities are not importing at this time and, in fact, have changed their thinking to export LNG. Two Louisiana facilities have received all the necessary permits and licenses from FERC (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission) for construction of their export facilities. The Cheniere, Sabine Pass facility is expected to process 2.76 Bcfd and is fully licensed for export in the initial phase. It is the first complex designed to liquefy and export natural gas from the continental U.S., and it is expected to begin LNG export in the first quarter of 2016. Cheniere also has approval for additional 1.40 Bcfd capacity expansions in the near future. In addition, the Sempra, Cameron LNG facility in Hackberry is under construction on its 1.7 Bcfd processing capability. Both facilities are fully licensed to export to free trade agreement (FTA) countries. Nine other LNG projects in Louisiana have been proposed or are in the early stages of the permitting/trade approval process – a mix of smaller-scale new facilities and proposed expansions of facilities that have already been approved.
