
## DECEMBER 2017

The average number of active drilling rigs in the U.S. is increasing, according to Baker Hughes Inc. data. In November 2017, the average active drilling rig count in the U.S. was 910, a 61% increase from November 2016; while in Louisiana State lands and water, the average active drilling rigs count was 43, a 40% increase from November 2016. The increase occurred due to oil prices slowly rising to above \$50 per barrel and gas prices mostly remaining around \$3 per MMBTU over the last year. The November average spot price for Louisiana Light Sweet crude oil was \$62.61 per barrel, a 33% increase from November 2016 when it was \$46.74. The November average gas spot price was \$2.83 per MMBTU in Louisiana, 12% higher than in November 2016 when it was \$2.42 per MMBTU. Hopefully, the number of active drilling rigs will continue to rise as oil prices continue over \$50 per barrel and gas prices maintain \$3 per MMBTU.
