Louisiana's Declining Oil Production: A 2018 Update



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
## Highlights\_

#### **APRIL 2018**

The U.S. rig count is increasing. After 2017, where the U.S. active rig count increased nationally from 404 rigs in May 2016, and was the lowest recorded rig count since 1999, the U.S. active rig count has rebounded to 993 rigs as of March 29, 2018, according to Baker Hughes. The doubling of the active rig count in the U.S. reflects the increasing oil and gas prices, with West Texas Intermediate (WTI) prices plunging as far as \$26.19 per barrel on February 11, 2016 and closed on March 29, 2018 at 64.94 per barrel, more than double the price from a little over two years ago. The increase in price can be attributed to the OPEC production limits implemented in January and an increasing global demand for oil.

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
