
# Highlights\_

## SEPTEMBER 2018

Louisiana's natural gas spot price averaged \$2.75 per MMBTU in August. The September 2018 NYMEX Natural Gas at Henry Hub settlement price was \$2.895 per MMBTU, 7 cents higher than the August 2018 gas settlement price and 2.2% lower than the September 2017 gas settlement price. Price increases reflected warmer-than-normal temperatures in August, which led to increased demand from the electric power sector. The U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) reported the working gas in storage was 2,435 billion cubic foot (BCF) as of Friday, August 17, 2018, which represents a decrease of 21.9% from last year's inventory for the same period and 19.7% lower than the fiveyear average inventory.
