

In November 2019, the average active drilling rig count in the U.S. was 810, a 25% decrease from November 2018; while in Louisiana State lands and water, the average active drilling rigs count was 34, a 24% decrease from November 2018. The decrease occurred due to oil prices falling to the \$60 per barrel range and gas prices mostly decreasing to around \$2.50 per MMBTU over the last few months. The November average spot price for Louisiana Light Sweet crude oil was \$61.68 per barrel, a 7% decrease from November 2018, when it was \$66.01. The November average gas spot price was \$2.55 per MMBTU in Louisiana, 15% lower than in November 2018, when it was \$2.99 per MMBTU.
