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## Highlights\_

## DECEMBER 2020

The average number of active drilling rigs in the U.S. is decreasing year-over-year, according to Baker Hughes Inc. data. In November 2020, the average active drilling rig count in the U.S. was 236, a 71% decrease from November 2019; while in Louisiana State lands and water, the average active drilling rigs count was 27, a 21% decrease from November 2019. The decrease occurred due to lower demand, and hence lower oil prices, due to the pandemic. The November average spot price for Louisiana Light Sweet crude oil was \$42.43 per barrel, a 31% decrease from November 2019, when it was \$61.68. The November average gas spot price was \$2.59 per MMBTU in Louisiana, 1.5% higher than in November 2019, when it was \$2.55 per MMBTU.
