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SEPTEMBER 2020

Louisiana's natural gas spot price averaged \$2.27 per MMBTU in August. The September 2020 NYMEX Natural Gas at Henry Hub settlement price was \$2.589 per MMBTU, 72.5 cents higher than the August 2020 gas settlement price and 14.6% higher than the September 2019 gas settlement price. Price increase reflect warmer-than-normal temperatures nationally in August, which led to increased demand from the electric power sector. The U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) reported the working gas in storage was 3.420 billion cubic foot (BCF) as of Friday August 21, 2020, which represents a increase of 20.4% from last year's inventory for the same period and 14.7% higher than the five-year average inventory.
