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Louisiana Energy Facts

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Highlights

The Louisiana natural gas spot price has been \$3.79 per MMBTU in the first 10 months of 2021, \$1.90 greater than, or 100% higher than the first 10 months of 2020. The higher gas price was caused by a decrease of the supply of natural gas production,

stoppages due to Hurricane Ida, and increasing demand from the pandemic rebound. Working gas in storage was 3,548 BCF as of October 22, 2021, according to the EIA estimates. This represents a net increase of 87 BCF from the previous week, and it was 403 BCF lower than last year at this time, and 126

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
BCF lower the five-year average of 3,674 BCF. The expected average natural gas prices for the rest of 2021 and into 2022 is expected around \$5.00 per MMBTU, based on current production and demand levels.
