# Highlights

The West Texas
Intermediate (WTI)
September crude price
average was \$71.65 per
barrel. Prices have been
increasing from the lows
of last year on a steady
basis, and up over 50%
on the year. Crude oil
production in the United
States has remained

steady for most of the year. In June, 2021, the United States averaged 11.3 million barrels per day, with the Gulf of Mexico producing 1.8 million barrels per day. Compared with May, these daily average production numbers were relatively flat,

with a change in average production down 0.5% for the U.S. and down 1.4% for the Gulf. The WTI August crude price average was \$67.73 per barrel.


