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Highlights

The average number of active drilling rigs in the U.S. is decreasing yearover-year, according to Baker Hughes Inc. data. In November 2024, the count in the U.S. was 584, a 5.7% decrease from November 2023; while in Louisiana State

lands and water, the average active drilling rigs count was 33, a 25.0% decrease from November 2023. The decrease occurred can be attributed to lower overall prices as average active drilling rig compared to 2023, and due to an increase in domestic US supply. The November average spot price for Louisiana Light Sweet crude oil was \$71.54 per



barrel, a 10.7% decrease from November 2023, when it was \$80.13 per barrel. The November average gas spot price was \$2.11 per MMBTU in Louisiana, 22.1% lower than in November 2023, when it was \$2.71 per MMBTU.
