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
Highlights_

APRIL 2009

Natural gas spot prices continue to weaken. The April NYMEX futures contract for natural gas was \$3.63 per MMBTU, the lowest monthly settlement price since September 2002. The May futures contract price of \$3.59 per MMBTU (April 7, 2009) continues to show the downward trend. The April 2009 closing settlement price was the fourth consecutive closing settlement price that was lower than the previous one. Gas demand is expected to drop further. The U.S. Department of Energy data projects a 6 percent decline in gas demand in chemical and factory sector usage this year. Bloomberg reported that Ellen Hannan, an energy analyst from Greenwich, Connecticut, estimated a 6.3 percent decline in industrial demand for gas, and a 2 percent decline in natural gas consumption by power generators. Optimistic tropical storm forecasts are also contributing to the expectation that the natural gas supply will not be curtailed. Colorado State University reduced their prediction of named tropical storms in the Atlantic from 14 to 12. They also reduced the number of tropical storms predicted to turn into hurricanes from 7 to 6.

(Dollars/Barrel)


