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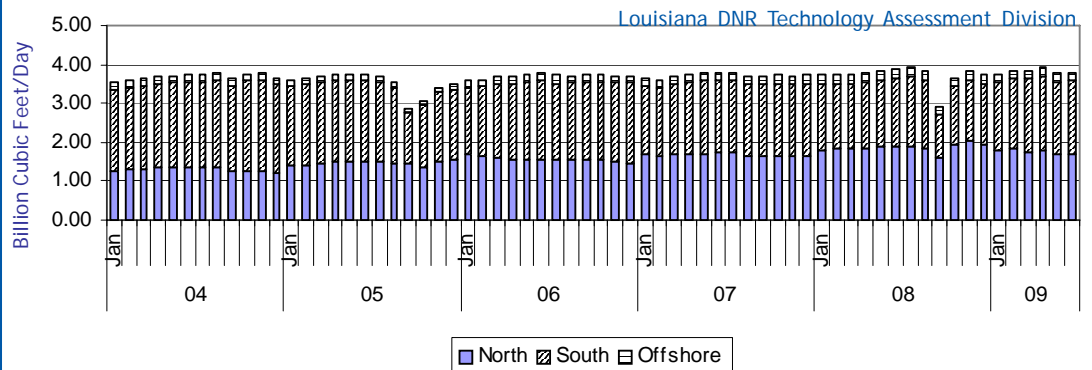
Highlights AUGUST 2009

The price of Louisiana Light Sweet crude (LLS) is approximately \$70.00 per barrel. The average price of LLS has dropped from \$137.80 per barrel in July 2008 to \$66.79 per barrel in July 2009. This is a 106% price decline from last year. The decline is the result of an over supply of crude, low demand for gasoline during the summer months and a decline in worldwide demand due to the slowdown of the global economy. The price of oil is projected to rise due to instability in Nigeria, a downward revision of Venezuela's proven crude reserves, a decline in crude production in Mexico and Russia, and increased demand for crude in China, Brazil, India and the Third World as the economy recovers from the recession.
