each year, Louisiana's underground utility infrastructure is jeopardized WHEREAS, by unintentional damage by those who fail to call to have underground

lines located prior to digging; and

undesired consequences such as service interruption, damage to the WHEREAS,

environment, personal injury, and even death are the potential results;

Louisiana law requires that anyone planning excavation or demolition WHEREAS.

> must notify Louisiana One Call and, if a facility must be located, personnel will be sent to mark the location of underground facilities at

no cost to the requesting party; and

Louisiana One Call, the state Department of Natural Resources and the WHEREAS,

state Office of Public Safety promote the national Call-Before-You-Dig number, 811, as well as the use of safe digging practices, in an effort to

reduce these damages; and

through education on safe digging practices, excavators and WHEREAS,

homeowners can save time and money keeping Louisiana and our nation safe and connected by making a simple call to 811 in advance of any digging project, waiting the required amount of time, respecting the

marked lines, and finally, digging with care around the marks; and

all parties agree that safe digging is a shared responsibility. WHEREAS,

I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim NOW, THEREFORE,

SAFE DIGGING MONTH

in the State of Louisiana.
